- 5. Treasurer's Report:
  - a. Collected approximately \$5200 for January Munch-a-Lunch, spent \$900 on Dominos for the first month of the year.

- 6. Administrator's Report:
  - a. In January classes participated in Lunar New Year activities, showcased around the school.
  - b. Black History Month grade five students have been reading morning announcements highlighting history and individuals through the month.
  - c. Hijab Awareness The school had speakers from older grades in George McDowel and Louis Riel Arts & Technology Centre (ATC) to present a PowerPoint to teach students about traditional head covering. Students will be asked if they would like to learn how to wear a Hijab and will be asked to bring their own scarf if they would like to participate.
  - d. The school is making plans to encourage more sharing of traditions among students, asking students to bring in items that are special to them, their culture, beliefs, or traditions. Show-and-Tell with a picture of the item will be planned up upcoming months.
